GRASS SEED AND DIRT

This is another program Sun decided to cancel. We used to get grass seed at the beginning of "Spring from the office, so I guess that was another money saving decision that affected our "community. So the Association is offering free grass seed to anyone wanting to fill in some "patches or ruts. We also have a lot of garden soil for free. We have a wheel barrel and "shovels, so all you need to do is come and get some.

You should not let your grass grow so high a mower "will stall trying to cut it. We have an agreement with several neighbors to cut, trim and blow "your grass for \$20. The company the park uses does a terrible job and charges "\$34 per cut. You neighbors can use the money, so contact the Association and we'll set "you up. If you have trouble affording it right now, let us know. We'll help you. To get the "special price you'll need to go through the Association." "DO NOT LET ANYONE CUT YOUR GRASS WITHOUT CLEANING THE CLIPPINGS. "IT LOOKS TERRIBLE REGARDLESS OF THE PRICE THEY CHARGE. "ASK THE ASSOCIATION.
